Kathlyn has an extensive background in developing and implementing solutions to homelessness and poverty. In San Francisco, she was Executive Director of Compass Family Services, a large nonprofit that provides a comprehensive range of services for homeless and very low-income families. In Norfolk, she was the Founder and Executive Director of Virginia Social Ventures, which operated the job training enterprise Spotlight Books. Kathlyn also served as Interim Executive Director at the Washington English Center, PFLAG National, and the Foodbank of Southeastern Virginia.

She holds a B. A. in sociology from U.C. Berkeley and a Ph.D. in politics from Princeton University. Currently, she serves on the board of the Center for Nonprofit Advancement in Washington, DC.
